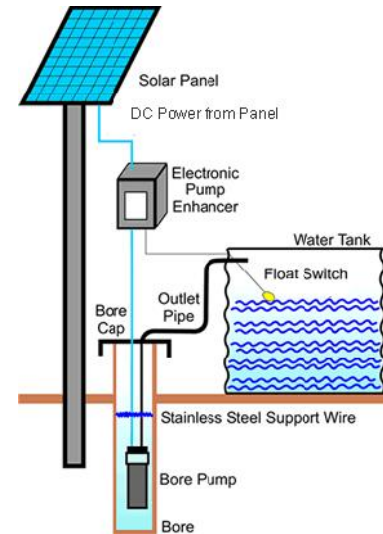

**What are open-pollinated Seeds?**

**Open-pollinated seeds** are produced when plants are allowed to pollinate naturally through insects, wind and water (water can actually carry pollen). As a result, open-pollinated varieties of the same species can cross with one another. But if you isolate the varieties properly, you can save seed year after year, which is unique versus an F1 hybrid from which you cannot save seed. **All of our 100% Organic seeds are open-pollinated.**

**Saving Seed.** If left to them their own devices, fleshy fruits naturally fall to the earth, where some of their seeds sprout when spring arrives again. Saving seeds from these plants mimics nature’s way—and it’s not at all difficult to do. But remember that only seeds from open-pollinated, not hybrid, plants will produce the same crop next year. (The packet that the original seeds arrived in will tell you whether the variety is open-pollinated or hybrid.) And, except for tomatoes, the plants shouldn’t be cross-pollinated by insects (which would happen if several varieties grew in the same area).

**How long will my seed last?** Most seed will last for 2-4 years if stored in a cool, dry, dark place. For best quality, seed needs to be fully dry before storing. Most seeds will keep best if stored in an airtight container in the freezer. Be aware that germination goes down over time, so you may need to sow more of your older seed to get the number of plants you want. Some types of seed, like onions and parsnips, lose viability much more quickly. For these it is best to buy or save new seed each year.

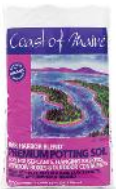

## How to Adjust Soil pH for Your Garden

Most garden soils have a **pH** between 5.5 and 8.0. This number helps you determine when and how to adjust your garden soil's pH level. If the pH level is below 6, the soil is too acidic, and you need to add ground limestone. If the measurement is above 7.5, the soil is too alkaline for most vegetables, and you need to add soil sulfur.

### How much limestone or sulfur do you need?

All Cooperative Extension Service offices, any soil lab, and many lawn and garden centers have charts showing how much lime or sulfur to add to correct a pH imbalance. The charts tell you how many pounds of material to add per 1,000 square feet, so you need to measure the size of your vegetable garden first. Then use these tables to figure out how much lime or sulfur you need to add to your soil.

### How to apply limestone or sulfur

The best way to apply sulfur and limestone to your soil is to use a *drop spreader* (the same machine you may use to apply lawn fertilizer). This simple machine doesn't cost very much, and it helps you spread the material more evenly. Some nurseries may even loan you a spreader or allow you to rent one inexpensively. You also can spread these materials by hand if you're careful and wear gloves. No matter how you spread the materials, make sure that you work the soil well afterward. Your soil uses limestone and sulfur most efficiently when it's tilled into the soil to a depth of 4 to 6 inches.

### Types of limestone and sulfur

You can purchase and apply different types of limestone to your soil. The type you use may depend on the type of nutrients your soil needs:

**Dolomitic limestone** contains magnesium, as well as calcium. Magnesium is one of the nutrients that a soil lab may test for, and even though it isn't in the top three (nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium), it's as important as calcium for plant growth. Use dolomitic limestone to adjust the pH if your soil test shows that your soil is low in magnesium.

**Pulverized limestone** is the most common and inexpensive acid neutralizer. Use this limestone if you don't need to add magnesium to your soil.

**Pelletized pulverized limestone** is a little more expensive than ordinary pulverized limestone, but it's cleaner, less dusty, and easier to use than both dolomitic and powdered limestone.

Sulfur comes in granulated and powdered form or mixed with other nutrients, such as ammonium sulfate and magnesium sulfate.
